The first order of business was the consideration of the minutes from the previous Carolina Regional Service committee meeting. Next was the old business concerns which had one proposal that was tabled until the next regional committee meeting. Before the lunch break the area concerns and reports were read and discussed by RCM's themselves. A few concerns that needed to be considered were, one the fact that in September and October of 2018 bank statements needed to be reviewed by all members attending the World Service Convention. Because money was stolen during the world convention in Florida, by credit card means. Second, How to help DRT/MAT people feel welcome during our meetings. And lastly, how to assist law enforcement officers wanting to get help for overdose citizens at our meetings.

After lunch roll call was taken and indicated that we had met quorum to conduct business. Questions and answers were conducted during the lengthy reading of the Subcommittee Reports and RD/AD reports. During the discussion of new business two in-house votes were taken and both were passed. The first was for the starting time of the regional meeting from 10 AM to 10:30 AM and the next was for the location of the next regional meeting. Which will be held in Columbia, South Carolina April 13th 2019. A lengthy discussion was held on the final treasure report given by the finance chair. Afterwards the motion for a donation to the world was accepted for \$1600 and passed. A Carolina regional help line 1- 855 -227 6262 was introduced to help connect people to meetings in the North and South Carolina region.

Before the adjournment the committee members were asked by the RD/AD to section off into five member groups to discuss questions on how to help Drug Replacement Therapy and Mental Health Assistant Treatment DRT\MAT people feel more welcome at our meetings. After the adjournment of the meeting the Lake Norman Area's RCM met with me to discuss an invitation to our area about having a mixed area learning day in the near future.
